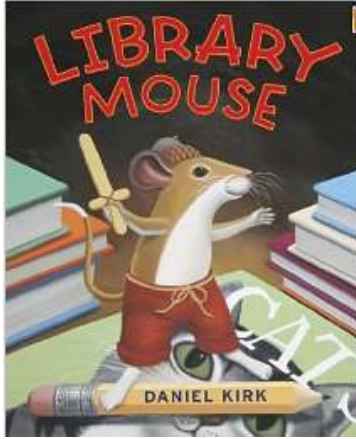


Library Mouse by Daniel Kirk

First Grade Lesson



Objective: Students will understand what an author does. Students will practice being authors themselves.

Materials:

- Copy of the book *Library Mouse* by Daniel Kirk.
- Tissue box, pencils, paper, mirror to create “Meet the Author” box like the one in the story
- Paper folded into little booklets
- Pencils
- crayons

Lesson Plan: Read the book *Library Mouse*. Discuss what an author is. Talk about the fact that all of us have a story to tell. Ask students what stories they have to tell. After the story tell students that Sam visited the library last night. Show them the “Meet the Author” tissue box and blank books. Let students create their own books. Display the books in the library for others to read.
